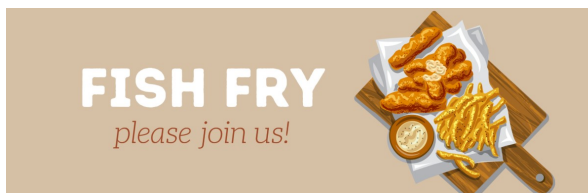
EDGE Camp
