Cenacle Holy Hour

As the Apostles prayed with Mary in the cenacle of the Upper Room, preparing themselves for the coming of the Holy Spirit, so in the cenacles we pray the rosary with Mary asking through the intercession of her Immaculate Heart for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit. We reflect on her words given to don Gobbi, we pray for our Holy Father and make our consecration to her Immaculate Heart. “And so, in cenacle with me, you are preparing the second Pentecost which is about to come so that, through the irresistible power of the Spirit of Love, the Church may be healed and the whole world renewed” (M294p).

St. Louis de Montfort in True Devotion to Mary mentioned, that “When the Holy Spirit, her spouse, finds Mary in a soul, he hastens there and enters fully into it. He gives himself generously to that soul according to the place it has given to his spouse. One of the main reasons why the Holy Spirit does not work striking wonders in souls is that he fails to find in them a sufficiently close union with his faithful and inseparable spouse” (36).
